The pair were parked in the Evo Towers car park in Wollaston, Wellingborough but disappeared between the evening of Friday 4 February 2011 and the morning of Sunday 6 February.

The trailer is pretty large and distinctive, and would have been around the Northamptonshire/Bedfordshire area at some point over the weekend as it left our premises. The Radical's chassis VIN number is 0049, and when it was taken its white bodywork was sporting a distinctive bright blue wrap, with lots of evo logos and race circuit maps. The four-wheeled trailer had a large 'RS2' logo on the back, and its VIN number is SJANTRSGBDAD111381.
