The upper and lower threaded bosses are the attachment points for the "nose frame." The cars were not originally designed with a crush box of any kind, and as a result came with a nose support frame that bolted to the **chassis** via the 4 threaded bosses. Once a crush box was designed, it attached to the front of the **chassis** (much the same way yours does) and the threaded bosses went unused.

I'll see if I can dig up a picture of the original nose frame. Jake Latham probably has one on his website somewhere.
