How to disable driver signature enforcement in Windows 8

1. First, swipe from the right side of your screen to show the charm bar and select "Settings"



2. Select "Change PC Settings" at the bottom right of the screen:



3. Select **"General"** settings (or **"Update and recovery"** then **"Recovery"** on some systems) and then under **"Advanced startup"** Click on **"Restart now"**:
